HISTORY OF THE AMERICAN UNION OF SWEDISH SINGERS.

PREFACE.



JN OUR DEAR OLD FATHERLAND — The Land of the Midnight Sun — Male Chorus singing has for generations back been practiced very extensively. In 1867 a chorus, composed of students from the university of Uppsala, Sweden, participated in an international singing contest, held in Paris. This Swedish chorus, being one of the smallest in membership (comprising only 100 voices) among those in the contest, was not considered to be of much consequence by the other participants, for the reason that very little was known of them outside of their own country previous to their appearance at this contest.

They were unfortunate also in the respect that theirs was one of the last numbers on an exceedingly long program, and that the judges — who, by the way, included some of the foremost composers, musicians and critics of their day — as well as the immense audience, had listened to every number and were by this time getting weary and tired, only wishing for the contest to come to an end, and the grand prize, which was to be awarded to the champion chorus, had already been conceded in the minds of judges, singers and listeners alike to the Belgian chorus, which had shown such superiority over the other choruses appearing, that this question was practically settled. The ovation that the Belgians received after their number had clearly shown that there was no chance for any of the previous choruses receiving the award, and hardly possible for any of the remaining ones to make the same impression.

The audience had had enough. Several were getting ready to leave, when the Swedish students lined up on the platform. Their appearance, however, attracted some attention and everybody lingered a while to see if their efforts would be worth listening to. The director, Mr. Arpi, being a man of short stature, in order to be seen by every one of his singers, climbed upon a chair in front of the chorus. He raised his baton, and forth rolled the mightiest volume of tone as from an immense organ. From the first sound the audience appeared spellbound, and the singers, feeling that they had made an impression, gained courage and sang as they never had sung before. The chair on which the leader stood broke down and he scrambled on the floor; the singers, however, never faltered, not the slightest break in the singing being detected, and Mr. Arpi was soon on his feet again, taking up his directing as if nothing had happened.

The enthusiasm on the part of the audience after the number was finished knew no bounds. Men cheered, women waved their handkerchiefs, hats and fans flew in the air. Members of the Belgian chorus, forgetting their defeat, rushed on the platform and

embraced the Swedes, even the judges came up and publicly congratulated the victorious singers and their director.

During their stay in Paris the Swedish singers were greeted as conquering heroes wherever they appeared. Being easily recognized on the streets, wearing the well known white student caps (similar to those now worn by the members of the A. U. S. S.), flowers were thrown at them, women even embracing them on the public thoroughfares.

This same chorus, the one from Uppsala University, has time and again repeated their triumph of '67 and still remains the foremost of Swedish male choruses. This is quite a distinction when it is considered that no town in Sweden, however small, is without its male chorus and in the larger cities, as Stockholm and Gothenburg, the competition between the numerous male choruses is very keen.

Sweden has justly been termed "a singing nation", and it is only a natural consequence that the cherished practice of male chorus singing should be kept up by the sons of such a nation, even after they have emigrated, and wherever they have congregated in any large numbers in this country one is sure to find among them a male chorus or quartet of more or less prominence.

THE AMERICAN UNION OF SWEDISH SINGERS

was organized Thanksgiving day, 1892, at a meeting in Chicago, to which nine societies, chiefly from New York, Chicago, Minneapolis, St. Paul and Rockford, had sent delegates. To-day the union numbers about 1000 singers, belonging to more than 50 different singing clubs in various parts of the country.

The first and highly successful festival of the American Union of Swedish Singers was held in Chicago in connection with the three official Swedish Days at the World's Fair in 1893. The second festival was held with two successful concerts at Carnegie Hall in New York city in 1897, the festival being postponed until said year on account of the Scandinavian Industrial and Art Exposition at Stockholm in King Oscar's jubilee year, when, after the festival in New York, a splendid chorus of 54 voices made a concert trip to Sweden, which may be characterized as one unbroken series of conquests and pleasure, the old country for the first time realizing the high standard attained by Swedish male chorus singing in America.

At the convention in conjunction with the singing festival in New York the Singers' Union, for practical purposes, was divided into sub-divisions, the Eastern and the Western, with biannual festivals for each and quadrennial festivals to be held jointly.

The History of the A. U. S. S. would not be complete without the mention of the latest developments, namely the forming of a division of the Union on the Pacific coast. Six societies located in San Francisco, Cal., Portland, Ore., Seattle, Wash., Everett, Wash. and Tacoma, Ore., during the exposition at Portland 2 years ago, organized a Pacific division, and are next month holding their first singing festival in the Golden Gate City.

During the latter part of July the Western Division are holding their festival in Moline, Ill., and the next joint festival two years hence, will be held in Greater New York.
