NOTE TO CORRESPONDENTS

Secretary-General Dag Hammarskjold is scheduled to leave on Friday evening for Beirut (Pan American World Airways, Flight 66, 7:30 p.m. Idlewild). He will arrive at Beirut, Saturday evening, 9:10 p.m.

On Sunday (1 December) morning, the Secretary-General will fly in a UN plane to Amman.

As presently planned, the Secretary-General's itinerary in the area includes visits to Amman, Jerusalem and Damascus. He plans to be back at UN Headquarters Sunday morning, 8 December.

The Secretary-General will be accompanied from Headquarters by Leo Malania of the Executive Office of the Secretary-General and William Ranallo, personal aide to the Secretary-General.

George Ivan Smith, Director of the UN Information Center in London, will join the party in Rome on Saturday, and Henri Vigier, political adviser of the United Nations Truce Supervision Organization, will join the party in Beirut.
