Dear Andy,

As David has gone to Lebanon I take the liberty to write to you directly to propose a small change in the schedule of the Secretary General's visit to Brussels.

In the original schedule which you approved, a visit of the United Nations Pavilion was to take place on June 26 in the afternoon to be followed by his attendance at the International Convention on Humanism. However, this later Convention will be held in town and not at the Exhibition and I am somewhat afraid that there will be no time to carry out the two functions.

I ~~would~~^{wish to} propose therefore that on June 25 the Secretary General ~~would~~ pay an informal visit to the Exhibition in the morning and that at 4.00 p.m. he would visit the UN Pavilion where Minister of State Gutt will remit to him a gold medal struck in honour of our participation in the Exhibition. (I shall be sending you personally the same gold medal after the Secretary General's trip to Brussels).

Could you cable me whether you approve the re-arranged time table as per enclosed note.
