SECRETARY-GENERAL LEAVES BEIRUT FOR NEW YORK

(The following was received from a UN Information Officer with UNOGIL, Beirut.)

Secretary-General Dag Hammarskjold and his party left Beirut for New York at 2:25 p.m. today, local time. He was seen off at the airport by Dr. Albert Moukheiber, Acting Foreign Minister of Lebanon, and by members and officials of the United Nations Observation Group in Lebanon (UNOGIL).

Also at the airport to see him off was the Swedish Minister to Lebanon, Ake M. Stolin.

Before leaving Beirut, the Secretary-General called on President Camille Chamoun and on Dr. Moukheiber.

Dr. Ralph J. Bunche, Under-Secretary of the United Nations, left Beirut for Geneva at 10 a.m. today, local time.

Yesterday afternoon (11 September), the Secretary-General visited General Fouad Chehab, the President-elect of Lebanon, at the General's residence. In the evening, the Secretary-General and his party and members of UNOGIL attended a dinner given by Dr. Moukheiber.
