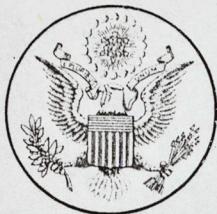

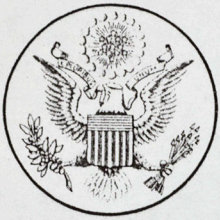

Dear Dag:


