MEXICO'S PRESIDENT

LIC.+ ADOLFO LOPEZ MATEOS,- Former Senator and Secretary of Labor in the last Administration. Took office on 1st December 1958. His term of office is 6 years.

The present Constitution of Mexico is dated 1917. The constitutional system consists of two chambers, Senate and House of Representatives.

In his first address, after having taken oath of office as President of Mexico, the new President devoted the first paragraphs of his message to foreign relations and international organizations. In the paragraph concerning the United Nations, he stated:

"Thus our decision to participate, with increasing intensity, in the work of the institutions formed to create, maintain and promote a regime of law and collective progress: the United Nations and, in what concerns our Hemisphere, the Organization of American States".

CABINET

Secretary of Foreign Relations.- MR. MANUEL J. TELLO

Mr. Tello has had a long career in the Foreign Service. In the 1930's he was a member of the Mexican Delegation to the League of Nations. He was Secretary of Foreign Affairs in the late period of the Administration of President Miguel Aleman (1946-1952). From 1952 and until his appointment as Foreign Secretary on 1st December 1958, he was Ambassador of Mexico in Washington.

Mr. Goroztiza had held the same post during the last Administration.
