Resolution of the U.N. General
Assembly

The General Assembly,

Having examined the grave situation prevailing in Tunisia since 19 July 1961 which was the subject matter of the Security Council consideration at its meetings of 21, 22, 28 and 29 July 1961,

Noting with concern and regret that France has not fully complied with the provisions of the Interim Resolution S/4882 of 22 July 1961 of the Security Council,

Noting that the Security Council has failed to take further appropriate action in the premises,

Being convinced that the presence of French armed forces in Tunisian territory against the express will of the Tunisian Government and people constitutes a permanent source of friction and a threat to international peace and security,

1. Reaffirms the Security Council's interim resolution (S/4882) and requests the Government of France to fully implement the provisions of the operative paragraph I;
2. Recognizes the sovereign right of Tunisia to call for the withdrawal of all French armed forces present on its territory without its consent;
3. Calls upon the Governments of France and Tunisia to enter into immediate negotiations to devising peaceful and agreed measures in accordance with the principles of the Charter for the withdrawal of all French armed forces from Tunisian territory.
