UN SECRETARY-GENERAL DUE IN NEW YORK THURSDAY MORNING

(The following was received from a UN Information Officer with the UN Observation Group in Lebanon, Beirut.)

United Nations Secretary-General Dag Hammarskjold left Beirut at 2:10 p.m. (local time) today via Pan-American flight 67 due in New York at 8:30 a.m. EDT, Thursday, 26 June.

Mr. Hammarskjold was seen off at the airfield by Albert Moukheiber, Minister of Health and Chairman of the Liaison Committee appointed by the Lebanese Government to cooperate with the UN Observation Group; Blouad Ghorra, Political Director of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs; Leslie J. Carver, Acting Director of the UN Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees in the Near East; and members of the Observation Group. Upon leaving UNOGIL headquarters in Beirut, the Secretary-General told the press he had no comment to make.
