Dear Mr. Ambassador,

Enclosed please find two communications which are replies from the Danish and Dutch Governments to my request for a study of the possibility to lend assistance in the clearing of the Canal. It is obviously most desirable to get the approval of the General Assembly as soon as possible of whatever steps by the United Nations may be found appropriate in this matter. It is likewise obvious that it is most desirable to process the sending of the suggested experts down to the Canal area as early as possible.
