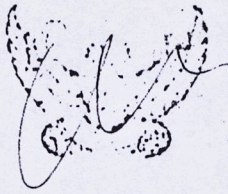

Dear Mr. Rifa'i,

With deepest regret and shock I have learned of the events in Amman through which Prime Minister Majali and many with him lost their lives. I have taken the liberty of addressing condolences personally to His Majesty, but I wish to send also to you and through you to the Government of Jordan the expressions of our deepest sympathy.

I can assure you of the continued support of the United Nations through me and my collaborators in the efforts to achieve stability and peace along the lines of the resolution of the General Assembly of 1958 which is the formal basis for a close co-operation established between your Government and the United Nations.

I have instructed Ambassador Spinelli to go forthwith to Amman in order to be available to the Government.
