Sir,

Referring to my Note No. 105, of the 22nd of November, I have the honour to inform you that my Government is prepared, should it be desirable, to provide transportation, as far as Naples or Port Said, in Brazilian ships for the contingent offered by Brazil to cooperate with the United Nations Emergency Force.

I have the honour to refer to your letter of 21 June 1957 concerning the service with the United Nations Emergency Force of the national contingent provided by my Government.

3. My Government accepts this proposal and agrees that your letter and this reply shall constitute an agreement between Brazil and the United Nations.
