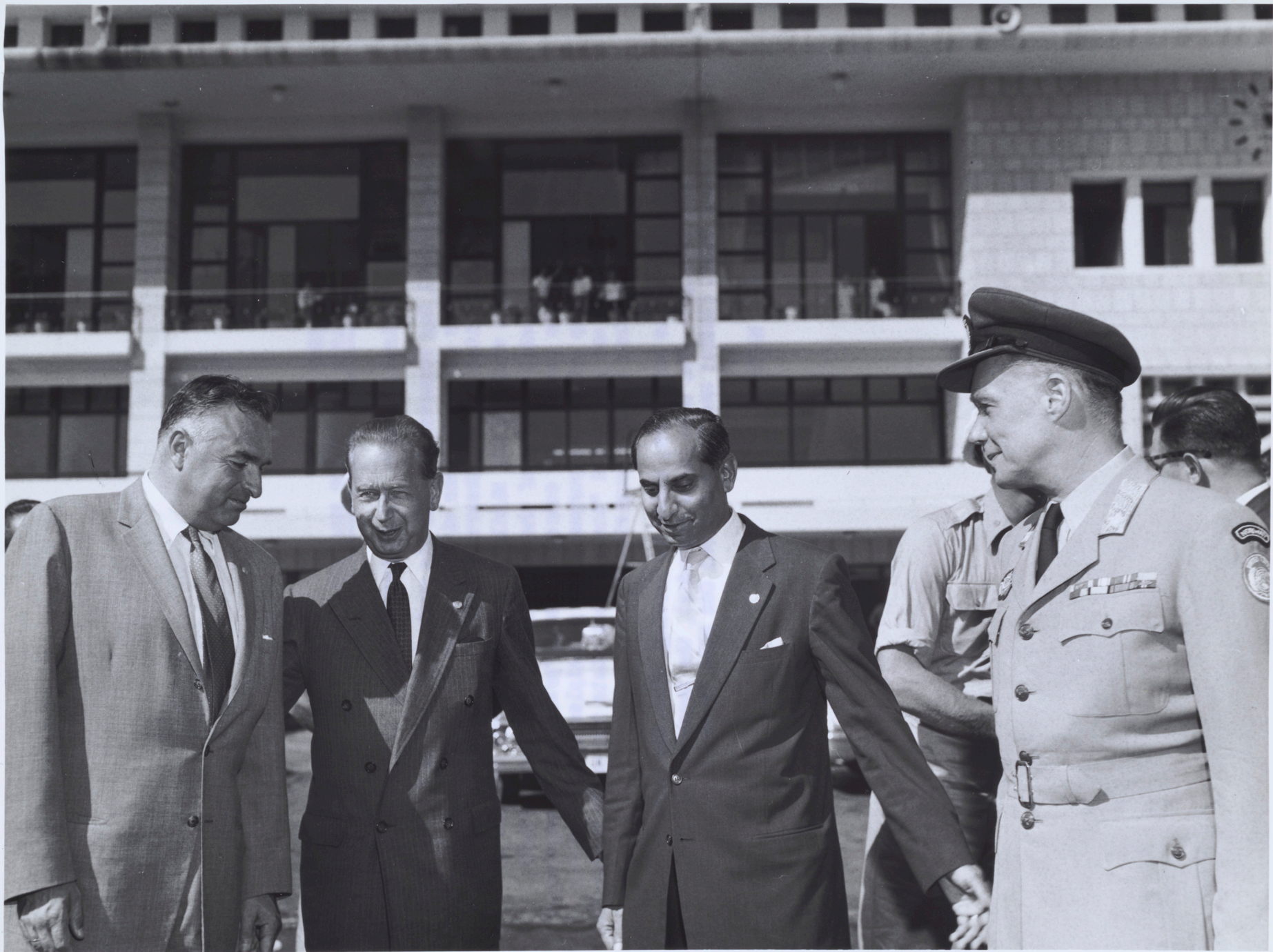
United Nations Secretary-General Dag HAMMARSKJOLD is seen here during a press conference held at UN headquarters today. Mr. Hammarskjold made a brief statement welcoming the outcome of the recently concluded Middle-East debate of the third emergency special session of the UN General Assembly. He told correspondents he planned to leave on Monday, 25 August, for Amman, Jordan, and continue on to Geneva to attend the opening on 1 September of the Second International Conference on the Peaceful Uses of Atomic Energy, returning afterwards to the Middle East for visits to Cairo, Beirut and probably Baghdad.

UN SECRETARY-GENERAL LEAVES BEIRUT FOR NEW YORK

UN 59679                      Beirut, Lebanon, 12 September 1958 -

UN Secretary-General Dag Hammarskjold and his party left Beirut for New York today after several days of discussions with Lebanese officials, and members and officials of the United Nations Observation Group in Lebanon (UNOGIL). The Secretary-General's visit to the Middle East followed the request of the third emergency special session of the General Assembly that he make, in consultation with the governments concerned, such "practical arrangements" as would adequately help uphold the purposes and principles of the Charter in relation to Lebanon and Jordan and "thereby facilitate the early withdrawal of the foreign troops from the two countries."
