During visit which I made to Berne yesterday in order discuss general administrative questions I had opportunity to meet M. Petitpierre who raised some protocol questions arising from point of view of Swiss Federal Government concerning Foreign Ministers Conference. Since four ministers will not be official guests of Swiss Government and they are meeting in Palais N. Petitpierre does not intend himself to greet them at airport but Swiss Federation will be represented by Chief of Protocol and perhaps Secretary General of the Department Politique. However as gesture of courtesy he wishes invite four ministers to lunch or dinner and is very desirous this should take place while you are in Geneva since he would be most happy to see you again on this occasion. If you are able accept this invitation he would envisage a table plan where you would be placed opposite him; this would solve their protocol problems and at same time give due recognition position ambassadeur Geneva. M. Petitpierre would very much like know your reactions this plan and to have any suggestions you might wish to offer. Would you be good enough to let me have your reply as soon as possible and I will contact him immediately.
