SECRETARY-GENERAL POSTPONES DEPARTURE FOR THE CONGO

UN Secretary-General Dag Hammarskjold announces that he has postponed his departure for Leopoldville until the evening of Tuesday, 26 July 1960. The reason is that he, at the request of Prime Minister Patrice Lumumba of the Republic of the Congo, wants to make himself available for discussions with the Prime Minister on the further development of UN assistance to the Congo.

The Secretary-General has arranged for Philippe de Seynes, Under-Secretary for the Department of Economic and Social Affairs, Robert Heurtematte, Commissioner for Technical Assistance, and H.S. Bloch, who has served as a technical assistance expert in the present mission in Leopoldville, to attend discussions with the Prime Minister on technical assistance to the Republic of the Congo.

SECRETARY-GENERAL TO LEAVE ON TUESDAY
FOR LEOPOLDVILLE VIA BRUSSELS

Secretary-General Dag Hammarskjold will leave for Leopoldville on Tuesday, 26 July 1960, at 9:30 p.m. After a stop-over of six hours in Brussels, Wednesday morning for discussions with the government, he will proceed directly to the Republic of the Congo. The Secretary-General will be accompanied by his personal aide, William J. Ranallo. On the final flight to the Congo he will be joined by Heinrich A. Wieschhoff, Director, Department of Security Council Affairs, and Michael Potrubatch, Personal Assistant to the Secretary-General.

As already announced, it is the intention of the Secretary-General to proceed from Leopoldville to the Union of South Africa and to return from there to Leopoldville.
