Dear Raúl,

In response to Guy Trancart's letter of 11 April, I had a conversation with Mr. Wilhelm Wachtmeister, Personal Assistant to the Secretary-General, about the Secretary-General's plan to visit Latin America, and on a strictly confidential basis and for your personal information I am able to transmit to you the following information.

For a long time now the Secretary-General has been invited and has intended to visit the West Coast countries — Chile, Bolivia, Ecuador and Peru. He cannot at this time fix his plans so much in advance; therefore his projected visit must be regarded as tentative and subject to change and even, perhaps, cancellation. As of now he is thinking of visiting the countries in question towards the end of August or perhaps at the beginning of September. The entire trip will certainly not be longer than two weeks. He will presumably remain about two to three days in each country.

You may be assured that when the Secretary-General's plans become more definite you will be informed as far in advance as possible.
