

Dear Mr. Hammerskjold,

I greatly regret that you were unable to broadcast today in the BBC Home Service programme "At Home and Abroad", but I fully appreciate the reasons which prevented you.

May I nevertheless take the opportunity to ask whether you would consider broadcasting a statement or interview in this programme on your return from China, if you are again visiting London? "At Home and Abroad", which is transmitted twice a week on Tuesdays and Fridays, is a half-hour programme made up of contributions from authoritative speakers on current affairs. The Prime Ministers of France, India, Pakistan, China and Japan, in addition to many leaders of political life in Britain, have taken part in this programme.
