Sir,

With reference to my letter of 19 November last I have the honour to transmit to you the following additional information regarding the aid offered by Finland for relief in Hungary:-

1. The Finnish Red Cross has shipped to Hungary foodstuffs to a value of 20 million mark and clothes to a value of 10 million marks;
2. The Finnish Red Cross will take over one of the camps established in Austria for Hungarian Refugees;
3. The funds raised in Finland for the benefit of Hungary so far amount to 175 million marks (some \$757.500:-).
