FULL STORY ON YOUR INTENTIONS stop SUBSEQUENTLY SHE AND  
HAMILTON AGREED REQUEST EDITOR HOLD STORY UNTIL EITHER SUNDAYS  
EDITION OR WHEN SUCH STORY BREAKS ELSEWHERE WHICH TIMES STAFF  
CONSIDER INEVITABLE stop SHE REVEALED HOWEVER THAT FRIEDMAN

In this connection, would appreciate your answers to following questions: 1. When is de Seynes due destination; 2. What is precise relation of Wahlen to de Seynes mission. Would appreciate receiving your reply tomorrow Friday, as story always liable to break through other source.
