COMPRISED CHAPTER ONE BRACKET FOOD AND AGRICULTURE  
SUPPLY BRACKET AND ALSO INTRODUCTION AND CHAPTER THREE

AS CABLED FAO FROM GENEVA WEDNESDAY 16/1 STOP  
FULL TEXT ISSUED BY FAO AND CONVERING PRESS RELEASE  
ALREADY AIRMAILED PELT WHO HAS JUST TELEPHONED  
REPORTING HE IS CABLING ROME REVISED TEXT INTRODUCTION  
AND CHAPTER THREE BUT IN VIEW OF LENGTH WILL NOT  
REACH US FOR SOME TIME STOP WHILST REGRETTING DIFFERENCE

BETWEEN NEWYORK AND ROME VERSIONS DO NOT THINK TEXT  
RELEASED FAO WILL BE LARGELY QUOTED AS NEWYORK IS  
MISSING FULL REPORT AND RELEASED THEIR VERSION MANY HOURS  
BEFORE FAO VERSION ISSUED HERE STOP HAD NATURALLY ASSUMED  
TEXT RECEIVED FROM GEN

VA WAS FINAL TEXT IN VIEW IMMINENCE  
RELEASE REPORT AND NO INDICATION FURTHER EXTENSIVE  
ALTERATIONS LIKELY APART FROM EVING SECTION NOT  
RELEASED BY FAO STOP HAVE ALSO RECEIVED FROM PELT

CABLE IS AGREEING FAO RELEASE SECTION REPEAT SECTION REPORT DEALING  
WITH FOOD AND AGRICULTURE AS COVERING ALL REFERENCE IN REPORT  
THESE SUBJECTS STOP INTRODUCTION AND CHAPTER III AS RECEIVED FROM  
GENEVA DEALT ALMOST EXCLUSIVELY FOOD AND AGRICULTURE REQUIREMENTS

THUS SUPPLEMENTING SEPARATE CHAPTER STOP THEREFORE CONSIDERED THEM

NOT INCLUDE EWING CHAPTER ON NON FOOD REQUIREMENTS BUT EXPLAINED

BUT BELIEVE UNLIKELY CAUSE UNFORTUNATE CONSEQUENCES STOP ONLY
