Dear Mr. D. Kublik-Jessen,

I thank you for your letter of November 27. With the doubts in your mind I appreciate your writing to me and the way in which you wrote.

Your observations are thoughtful, and if the facts were what you have been led to believe by press reports, I would agree with your conclusions. However, as so often, the true story, obviously, has not been considered to make news, or news with a desirable colour.

Although I hesitate to use material which, although not secret, for the moment I would not like to see published, I feel that the character of your letter entitles me to do so in sending you a short memorandum which straightens out the most important misrepresentations (while to all possible extent avoiding to re-open the issue and, therefore, naturally not complete).
