1. Iranian Representative, on instructions from his Foreign Minister, today asked that following "highly confidential" message be conveyed to you. Text follows: "13 July 1959. With reference to the radio and broadcasting campaign being waged against Iran by the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, the Government of Iran is contemplating further measures through the United Nations. New para. The Iranian Government, however, will take no action in this direction before being informed of the results of the Secretary General's contacts with the Foreign Minister of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics".

2. Representative stated that Soviet radio attacks continue with same intensity and admits that Iranian counter-attacks also continue. Iran hoping for a "truce" through your approach.

With reference to the radio and broadcasting campaign being waged against Iran by the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, the Government of Iran is contemplating further measures through the United Nations.

The Iranian Government, however, will take no action in this direction before being informed of the results of the Secretary General's contacts with the Foreign Minister of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics.
