U.S.S.R. ACCEDES TO CONVENTION ON PRIVILEGES
AND IMMUNITIES OF THE UNITED NATIONS

UN 43407 - UNITED NATIONS, N.Y., 22 Sept. 1953 -

The Soviet Union today became the 39th Member State to have acceded to the Convention on Privileges and Immunities of the United Nations. Here, Mr. Andrei Y. VYSHINSKY, Permanent Representative of USSR to the U.N., shakes hands with Secretary-General Dag HAMMARSKJÖLD (right), after having presented his country's instrument of accession to the Convention. Looking on, at right, is Mr. Constantin STAVROPOULOS, Principal Director in charge of the UN Legal Department; at left is an interpreter.

The Convention provides, among other things, that U.N. property shall enjoy legal immunity in the signatory country, that the Organization's premises and archives shall be inviolable and its property free from taxes and custom duties, and that delegates to the U.N. as well as officials of the Secretariat shall enjoy all privileges and immunities necessary to their work. Mr. Vyshinsky made one reservation, however, concerning the section which provides that differences between the U.N. and the signatory Member State shall be put before the International Court of Justice, and that the Court's opinion shall be binding to the parties.
