Katanga, Republic of the Congo, 14 Aug. 1960

UN Secretary-General Dag Hammarskjold and his party flew from Leopoldville to Elisabethville on 12 Aug. to carry out the terms of the Security Council resolution of 9 August which called upon Belgium "to withdraw immediately its troops from the province of Katanga under speedy modalities determined by the Secretary-General," and declared that the entry of the UN Force into Katanga "is necessary for the full implementation " of the resolution.
