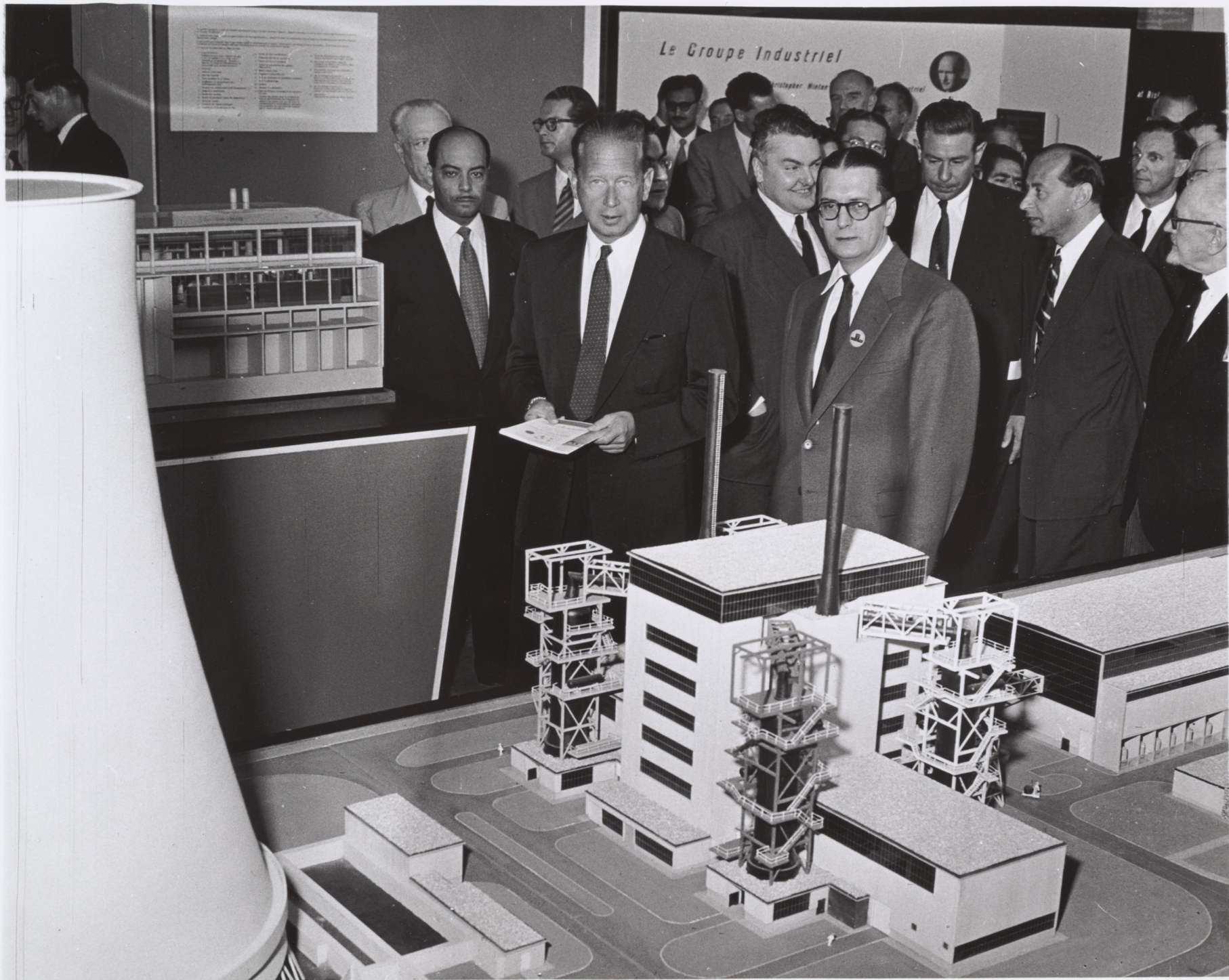

Katanga, Republic of the Congo, 14 Aug. 1960

UN Secretary-General Dag Hammarskjöld and his party flew from Leopoldville to Elisabethville on 12 August to carry out the terms of the Security Council resolution of 9 August which called upon Belgium "to withdraw immediately its troops from the province of Katanga under speedy modalities determined by the Secretary-General," and declared that the entry of the UN Force into Katanga "is necessary for the full implementation" of the resolution.

Here, at the Elisabethville airport the Secretary-General (at right) bids goodbye prior to flying back to Leopoldville. At left centre is the President of the Prov. Government of Katanga, Moïse Tshombe.
