Dear General Bull,

I am pleased to confirm by this letter the agreement under which you will serve as a member of an observation group to proceed to Lebanon so as to ensure that there is no illegal infiltration of personnel or supply of arms or other materiel across the Lebanese borders. This observation group is being appointed to fulfill the provisions of Resolution S/4022, passed by the Security Council on 11 June 1958.

While serving under this agreement, you will have the status of a United Nations expert responsible to the Secretary-General, but will not be subject to the Staff Regulations and Staff Rules which apply to regular staff members.

You will receive a daily honorarium of \$50.00 net (not subject to the United Nations Staff Assessment Plan), for each day while you are serving under this agreement including intervening Saturdays, Sundays and holidays, and also including any time spent in travelling. In addition, you will receive a subsistence allowance of \$20.00 a day.

The United Nations will be responsible for the cost of first-class transportation for yourself to and from any of the places which may be visited by you as a consequence of executing the assignment.

If the terms of this proposal are satisfactory to you, I shall appreciate your signing and returning a copy of this letter to me.
