Your Excellency

I have the honour on instructions from Her Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom to request you, in your capacity as President of the Security Council, to call a special meeting of the Council under Article 28 of the Charter to discuss certain problems of the Middle East, at which members might be represented by heads of government or other specially designated representatives. It would be the intention of Mr. Harold Macmillan, Prime Minister of the United Kingdom, to attend such a meeting. Her Majesty's Government in the United Kingdom propose that subject to the agreement of other members of the Council this meeting should take place on the 12th of August.

Her Majesty's Government further propose that there should be early consultations between the permanent representatives of the members of the Security Council, with the assistance of the Secretary-General, in order to reach agreement on the formulation of the item which the Council would discuss and on other pertinent matters of procedure.

Your Excellency
