TEXT OF JOINT COMMUNIQUE IN CAIRO AFTER  
CONCLUSION OF TALKS BETWEEN PRESIDENT GAMAL NASSER  
AND HIS ROYAL HIGHNESS PRINCE FAISAL AL-SAUD  
August 15 - 18, 1958

---

President Gamal Abdel Nasser, President of the United Arab Republic, and His Royal Highness Prince Faisal Ibn Abdel Aziz Al-Saud, Crown Prince and Prime Minister of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, met during the Prince's visit to Cairo.

The Meeting aimed at the clarification of the atmosphere between the two sister countries and the strengthening of ties of cooperation and brotherhood between them. The meeting also aimed at working for the consolidation of pillars of Arab Nationalism on the basis of non-alignment and positive neutrality. The international situation, as well as, the present situation in the Arab countries and the Middle East were discussed.

The two countries declare they don't approve the presence of any foreign forces on soil of any Arab country. They also condemn intervention in other people's affairs by any foreign country, or countries which exposes world peace and security to danger.

The exchange of views resulted in complete agreement and consolidation of ties of friendship and brotherhood between the two sister countries.
