Mr. Dag HAMMARSKJÖLD, Secretary-General of the United Nations, Mr. Hammar skjöld, who was born on 29 July 1905, in Jönköping, Sweden, holds degrees in Law and Political Economy from the University of Uppsala. In 1933, he was Assistant Professor on Political Economy at the University of Stockholm. He also had a notable career in the field of finance. From 1936 to 1945, he was Secretary-General of the Swedish Government's Department of Finance. In 1946, he held the position of Specialist in Finance in the Swedish Foreign Ministry, with the rank of Envoy. He has also served as Chairman of the Board of the National Bank of Sweden and as Vice-Chairman of the Executive Committee of the Organization for European Economic Cooperation. He became his country's Minister of State in 1950. Mr. Hammar skjöld has already had experience of work with the United Nations: he served as Vice-Chairman of his country's delegation to the 6th session of the General Assembly, in Paris, and as Chairman of the delegation to the 7th session, the first part of which he was in New York.
