Brådskande för Hammarskjöld från Cordier.

FN:s telegram nr 1 den 14 maj.

1. In conference with Tsarapkin today agreed first step might be cable from you offering appointment with terms to Chernyshev. Suggest you might send cable adressed to him routed to me for transmission through Soviet Mission to him. Assume cable should contain inter alia reference to Zinchenko nonreturn; consideration of alternative candidat^es; offer to Chernyshev for completion of Zinchenko's term; terms of contract including reference \$ 23.000 gross, \$ 15.000 net with \$ 7.000 representation allowance plus removal costs plus education grant if children of school age; if able to accept appointment, interested in his view as to when he might take up his duties referring to your own return to New York around the middle of June. If you agree this procedure will transmit your return cable to Soviet Mission as indicated.

2. Need some record of Zinchenko's resignation. Assume this might be done your letter Vyshinsky re yesterdays conversation.

3. Lodge happy to hear of developments and favorable result. Appointment under these terms wholly defensible. Stated he too had complimented you on your independence. Will contact Jebb on his return on Monday.

4. Riley has replied favorably to your cable requesting him to stay another week or two until successor appointed. Assuming you will confer soon with Swedish military officials regarding Bennike.

5. Telegram adressed to you from Santa Cruz as chairman

of SA Commission refers to interview with you in course of which "vous avez bien voulu me faire connaître que vous seriez disposé à utiliser vos bons offices auprès du Gouvernement de l'Union Sudafricaine pour faciliter la coopération du Gouvernement avec notre commission". Commission feels therefore it must first explore possibilities of "votre suggestion" and requests you to get in touch with SA Delegation "pour rechercher avec elle les moyens de coopération les plus efficaces qu'il serait possible d'établir". Alternative forms of such cooperation are then listed in following order of preference:

- A. Admission of Commission to Union Territory.
- B. Admission of one or several members of Commission à titre personnel.
- C. Admission of delegated representative of Commission.
- D. Qualified representatives of SA Government to testify on problem before Commission. Alternative A. emphasized as most effective. Protitch feels that contents of this telegram do not correspond exactly to views expressed previously. Would appreciate instructions.

6. Notice given to Glaser today in accordance ~~to~~ your instructions.

7. Guerrero happy to have dinner with you thursday 28th of May.

8. Hope you had a pleasant trip. Warm regards to you and Lind.

This is for purpose of permitting Secretary General ^{to determine} whether or not he should take interim action with respect to employee prior to completion of procedures. This action without prejudice to right to full hearings as provided herein. 3. Standards to be used by board in making advisory determination with respect to US citizen who is employee of, or being considered for employment, by UN, shall be, whether or not on all evidence there is reasonable doubt as to loyalty of person involved to Government of USA. 4. Board shall consist of not less than three impartial persons who shall be officers or employees of Civil Service Commission. 5. Board is authorized to make advisory determinations on basis of criteria mentioned above. 6. 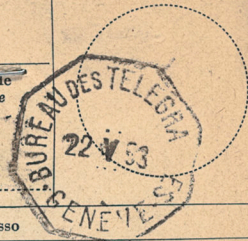

Thank you for your 679, 21 May. Have noted all points.

1. Executive Order - Immediately upon receipt this morning text your cable was given to Price who at once contacted Hall who transmitted your message to Lodge emphasizing request for postponement as personal from you to Lodge. As Lodge in Washington today for cabinet meeting Price felt Hall was best channel for prompt communication .

Even before receipt your telegram I had suggested to Price yesterday after consultation with Gross that he would take up with Hall informally the following suggestions for amendment:

- a) paragraph 5 third sentence - insert " advisory" before determinations. Although advisory appears elsewhere, its use in this context softens effect and helps maintain proper relationship between Board and Secretary-General.
- b) same sentence replace "the responsibility with respect to integrity etc" by "his responsibility", again to maintain position Secretary-General.
- c) at end of same sentence delete everything after "employed by United Nations". Since US felt impossible delete reference to jurists' report alone, we felt deletion of all references to any instruments defining Secretary-General's responsibilities might serve (de dash?) emphasize omission jurists' report. General considerations same as those stated your telegram.
- d) paragraph 6, second sentence to read "for purpose of assisting the Secretary-General in determining whether or not he should take action with respect to the employee or person being considered for employment prior etc."
"Assisting" to replace places US authorities in proper relationship to Secretary-General. Omission "interim" obviates implication of any automatic response by Secretary-General to receipt derogatory information and gives greater flexibility to timing Secretary-General's own decisions. Insertion reference to applicants maintains consistency with other sections Executive Order and would have effect speeding up consideration of applicants by providing interim information to Secretary-General regarding them.

Hall appeared receptive to all above suggestions except c) above, since text Executive Order under discussion between Administration and key congressmen who wanted specific reference to basis Secretary-General's responsibilities, especially jurists' report.

2. Understand Price cabling you separately regarding outcome his effort secure postponement. Gross strongly feels no need bringing xxx (brnd) out new order before old order expires May 27. Pending cases under old Order can be easily picked up whenever new Order comes into effect.

3. Vyshinsky in today's letter requests me transmit text letter to you from Chernyshev acknowledging with gratitude and accepting offer. Proposes arrive New York about 20th June to take up duties. Original of letter will be sent in due course by surface mail. No referende Zinchenko. Will mail you draft press release regarding Chernyshev.

4. New York Times front pages article under headline "U.S. keeps alien pacifist out and American U.N. aides in". Story says number of U.S. citizens holding high positions have been kept from attending recent overseas meetings by "unusual delays" in issuing their passports. Delays attributed to State Department's policy of not granting passports until completion of loyalty checks. Julia Henderson mentioned as being compelled to change her plan to attend ACC meeting in Geneva. Article states Secretary-General discussed ~~possible~~ passport problem with members of US delegation and that Secretary-General "understood agreed with predecessor former Secretary-General Lie that Americans travelling for U.N. must carry U.S. passports." Spokesman for U.S. Mission denied delays connected with loyalty investigation but give no explanation. Story attracted widespread interest and written questions submitted by A.P. All other correspondents asked questions as to what was being done about the situation. General reaction among correspondents appears to be somewhat confused and somewhat negative.

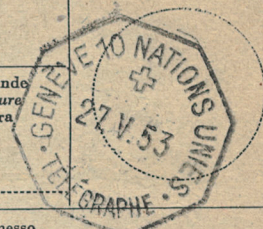
