Dear Mr. Hammerskjöld,

It was very kind of you to take the time to see me in New York and I appreciate your courtesy greatly.

I should like to assure you that we in the World Health Organization would be very pleased indeed if you could take a little time when you are here in Geneva for the meeting of the Administrative Committee on Co-ordination to meet some of our staff and see something of our work. The Sixth World Health Assembly will be closing its session on 22 or 23 May. The ACC meets on Monday, 25 May. We shall be having meetings with our Regional Directors here on the 26th and 27th and the Twelfth Session of our Executive Board begins on Friday, the 28th.
