AN HISTORIC & TIMELY RESOLUTION

*Dedicated to the Future of Man, on the Eve of His Observance
of the 10th Anniversary of the UNITED NATIONS*

To All People and All Governments:

Whereas, despite partial conflict during these crucial first ten years, the UNITED NATIONS has prevented World War and strengthened World Peace; and

Whereas, future historians may well record these first ten years of UNITED NATIONS peace as decisive; and

Whereas, whatever judgment future historians may render on these first ten years, they are nevertheless years of notable human progress and human betterment brought about directly by the UNITED NATIONS and its Specialized Agencies; and

Whereas, this great record of accomplishment is insufficiently understood and appreciated; and

Whereas, we believe the next ten years and the entire future of man should have the benefit of such understanding and such appreciation,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that we do hereby urge and recommend to all people and to all governments, including our own, that suitable action be taken to establish Monday, October 24, 1955, the 10th Anniversary of the ratification of the UNITED NATIONS Charter, as a special, legal, onetime holiday, so that on this one day of this one year all people everywhere may celebrate a worldwide holiday to be known as WORLDSDAY and in this way do what the human race has never done before, namely, join together at the same time to observe the same holiday with the same purpose everywhere of love and peace and freedom.
