Personnel Policy - Technical Assistance Administration

On the 1st of June I placed before you a memorandum entitled "TAA Personnel - French Nationals". The last paragraph of that memorandum read as follows:

" On the general situation we have been striving to reduce the proportion of United States and United Kingdom nationals in the professional category in the Technical Assistance Administration."

To illustrate the steps that have been taken in this field you may be interested in the following summary of separations from the TAA staff, by nationalities, since the 31st of December 1952. These separations include staff members terminated, transferred to other Departments or assigned to field missions:
