Procedure for Dealing with Suitability cases.

I am returning herewith your memorandum of 11 November 1953, subject as above, together with Mr. Price's comments thereon.

Referring to suggestion (a) of your memorandum, I have decided to request Mr. J. McDiarmid of the Bureau of Personnel and Mr. G. Sandberg of the Legal Department to collaborate in the preparation, for my use, of a memorandum analyzing the problems presented and classifying the individual suitability cases, with special reference to the question whether in each case security is involved.

Mr. McDiarmid and Mr. Sandberg should also start preparing the cases for presentation to the advisory board when it is established.

I am not prepared to take any decision regarding the composition of an ad hoc advisory group before the General Assembly has decided on the Draft Regulations submitted to it in the Report on Personnel Policy.
