A letter from D.H. — to Jacob Mark Lashly (member of the UN  
Administrative Tribunal)

11 December 1953

Dear Mr. Lashly,

I am pleased to inform you that the United Nations General Assembly, by a resolution adopted at its 471st meeting, held on 9 December 1953, appointed you as a member of the United Nations Administrative Tribunal for a period of three years commencing 1 January 1954.

In extending to you my personal congratulations upon your appointment, may I also take this opportunity of expressing the sincere hope that you will find it possible to accept this appointment which, as I am sure you are aware, is one that I consider of the highest importance in terms of the opportunity it offers for constructive service to the United Nations. I would be very much obliged if you would kindly let me know at your earliest convenience, of your willingness to accept.

Travel expenses incurred by members attending sessions of the Administrative Tribunal will be paid by the United Nations, together with an allowance of \$25.00 a day during meetings held at Headquarters in New York.

The Executive Secretary of the Tribunal will be communicating with you shortly to inform you of the Tribunal's calendar insofar as this has been established over the next several months. He will also forward a copy of the Tribunal's Statute, together with such other documentation as may prove helpful. If there are any questions
