Dear Mr. Sarper,

My travel plans for my visit to your country have now been finalized.

I shall be arriving in Turkey on Thursday, 19 January. I shall be travelling by special United Nations plane from Athens, which is scheduled to arrive at Istanbul at 11.45 a.m., depart Istanbul at 2.00 p.m. and arrive Ankara 4.00 p.m. I shall leave Ankara for Cairo on Saturday, 21 January, at 8.30 a.m.

I shall be accompanied by Mr. Ahmed S. Bokhari, Under-Secretary for Public Information, Mr. George Ivan Smith, Director of the United Nations Information Centre in London, and Mr. William Ranallo, my personal aide.

I should appreciate it if you would transmit this information to your Government.

I look forward with great pleasure to the opportunity of visiting your country and of meeting with the officials of your Government.
