Secretary-General's trip

I confirm my telegramme of yesterday reading as follows:

"SECGEN BOKHARI IVANSMITH RANALLO ARRIVING CAIRO EX ANKARA
UNTSO PLANE TWO TWENTY PM SATURDAY JANUARY TWENTYFIRST
LEAVING SAME PLANE ELEVEN AM MONDAY JANUARY TWENTY THIRD
MAKE NO COMMITMENTS FOR PUBLIC FUNCTIONS LETTER FOLLOWS."

..... I attach copy of the Secretary-General's itinerary for your information. The party from London to Karachi will consist of the Secretary-General, Professor Bokhari, George Ivan Smith and Ranallo. So far as I know it is anticipated that the Secretary-General will be the official guest of the Government in each country, but arrangements are still in process. It will therefore be for the Foreign Office to make any arrangements for him and you should take no engagements and make no commitments on his behalf. On arrival the Secretary-General will, of course, talk with any correspondents, etc. who may come to the airport.

There will be no need for you to accompany the Secretary-General to Beirut, Damascus and Rangoon as, in addition to Professor Bokhari and George Ivan Smith, he will be looked after in those places by the UNRWA staff.

If you want further instructions you are welcome to ask for them and if new facts come to my knowledge of which you should be informed I will communicate with you again.
