Monday, 23 January 1956

- 1700 Arrival at Lod Airport.
The Secretary-General will be received by the
Minister for Foreign Affairs, Mr. Moshe Sharett,
and senior United Nations officials in Israel.
- 1730 - 1830 From Lod Airport to Jerusalem by car, accom-
panied by the Minister for Foreign Affairs.
- 2000 Dinner at the residence of the Minister for
Foreign Affairs.
- Overnight At King David Hotel, Jerusalem.
