A letter from D.H. — to Prof. Louis Leprince-Ringuet
(Ecole Polytechnique, Paris)

10 June 1955

Dear Professor Leprince-Ringuet,

During the forthcoming International Conference on the Peaceful Uses of Atomic Energy at Geneva from the 8th to the 20th of August, there will be a series of evening lectures on broad scientific subjects by speakers of world repute. One evening lecture will be devoted to the subject of elementary particles. My Advisory Committee has suggested that you and Professor Bethe of the United States be invited to deliver the lectures that evening.

I am pleased to extend the invitation herewith and I sincerely hope, in the interests of the delegates and of the scientific public who will attend, that you will be able to accept. Should you do so, I would suggest that you communicate with Professor Bethe with a view to co-ordinating the subject matter of the two lectures.

As the lectures will have to be interpreted simultaneously into other languages, it would be very helpful if we could have, before the opening date of the Conference, the text (or at least a rough text) of your lecture so that the interpreters may study it in advance.
