

SUBJECT: Tenth Anniversary.

It ~~has been~~<sup>is</sup> suggested that you use the occasion of your forthcoming visit to Geneva for the ACC meetings to give a 10th anniversary speech on April 25 in the old League Assembly hall at the Palais.

The date marks the opening of the San Francisco Conference in 1945. The setting links the post-World War I effort for effective world organization with the post-World War II effort.

The immediate audience could be a combination of the Geneva staff and the public. A sober, long-range ideological speech on the role of the United Nations in relation to the trends of world development -- in such a setting and on this anniversary date -- should command wide attention in the press and radio everywhere. It would also help to redress a little the balance between Europe and America in your speaking engagements.

If you agree, we can proceed to make preliminary arrangements with Geneva and, if you wish, submit to you a working draft.
