Dear Mr. Asha,

This is to confirm that after some adjustments in the Secretary-General's itinerary made necessary by commercial plane schedules, he and his party plan to be in Damascus at the time originally indicated. That is to say, he will arrive in Damascus around three p.m. Friday, 27 January. He has decided to travel by car from Beirut to Damascus. He will leave Damascus by special UN plane on Saturday, 28 January at 8.00 a.m.

I would appreciate it if you would inform your Government regarding this schedule.

I shall also be happy to receive from you at your earliest convenience any information that you may have regarding the plans of your Government for the Secretary-General's visit.
