Dear Dr. Pachachi,

I telephoned you yesterday regarding the stepping up of the Secretary-General's schedule by twenty-four hours. I now have to inform you that new developments in the Secretary-General's itinerary as affected by commercial plane schedules make it necessary for him to revert once more to the original schedule. That is to say, he will arrive in Baghdad at eleven a.m. on Saturday, 28 January by special United Nations plane and will leave for Karachi Sunday, 29 January at six a.m.

I am sorry about the changes in schedule and hope that it has not been too much of an inconvenience to the officials of your Government.

I would appreciate it if you would convey this final schedule to your Government and if you could inform me at your earliest convenience of any plans that your Government might be formulating regarding the Secretary-General's visit.
