UNAFE 618 PACE AND PROBLEMS OF ASIAN ECONOMIC PROGRESS WILL BE REVIEWED WHEN UNITED NATIONS ECAFE WILL MEET FOR ITS TWELFTH ANNUAL SESSION IN BANGALORE INDIA FEBRUARY 2 TO 14. OPENING MEETING OF SESSION WHICH IS SOMETIMES DESCRIBED AS ECONOMIC PARLIAMENT OF ASIA WILL BE ADDRESSED BY PRIME MINISTER NEHRU DAG HAMMARSKJOLD UN SECRETARY GENERAL PHILIPPE DE SEYNES UN UNDER SECRETARY FOR ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL AFFAIRS AND P S LOKANATHAN ECAFE'S EXECUTIVE SECRETARY.

SOME TWO HUNDRED REPRESENTATIVES FROM 24 ASIAN AND NON ASIAN COUNTRIES AND TERRITORIES WILL BE PRESENT AMONG THEM CABINET MINISTERS SENIOR GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS AND LEADING ECONOMIC AND FINANCIAL EXPERTS AS WELL AS OBSERVERS FROM VARIOUS UN SPECIALIZED AGENCIES AND NON GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS.

EARLIER ECAFE'S COMMITTEE ON INDUSTRY AND TRADE WILL MEET FOR ITS EIGHTH SESSION IN BANGALORE JANUARY 24 TO 31.

REPRESENTED AT TWO BANGALORE CONFERENCES WILL BE ALL ECAFE MEMBERS: AFGHANISTAN, AUSTRALIA, CAMBODIA, CEYLON, CHINA, FRANCE HONGKONG, INDIA, INDONESIA, JAPAN, KOREA, LACS, MALAYA, AND BRITISH BORNEO, NEPAL, NETHERLANDS, NEW ZEALAND, PAKISTAN, PHILIPPINES, THAILAND, USSR, UNITED KINGDOM, USA AND VIETNAM.

ONE OF THE HIGHLIGHTS OF COMMISSION'S SESSION WHICH IS ECAFE'S TOP DELIBERATIVE AND POLICY MAKING BODY WILL BE TWO DAY DEBATE ON ASIA'S ECONOMIC SITUATION DURING WHICH DELEGATES WILL REPORT ON CURRENT PROBLEMS CONFRONTING THEIR COUNTRIES AND OUTLINE

THEIR GOVERNMENTS ECONOMIC POLICIES.

FACTUAL AND ANALYTICAL BACKGROUND FOR THIS DEBATE WILL BE PROVIDED BY SECRETARIES COMPREHENSIVE ANNUAL ECONOMIC SURVEY OF ASIA AND FAR EAST COPIES OF WHICH WILL BE READY IN PRINT JUST BEFORE COMMISSION SESSION BEGINS.

AMONG SALIENT PROBLEMS TO ATTACK PRINCIPAL ATTENTION OF DELEGATES WILL BE THOSE OF ECONOMIC PLACING REGIONAL COOPERATION IN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT POPULATION PROBLEMS INDUSTRIALIZATION AND DIVERSIFICATION OF ASIAN ECONOMIES AND VARIOUS UN ADVISORY SERVICES TO GOVERNMENTS.

THESE QUESTIONS WILL COME UP WHEN DELEGATES WILL REVIEW ECAFE'S FUTURE PROGRAMME OF WORK AND DETERMINE TO WHAT EXTENT EFFECTIVENESS OF COMMISSION AS INSTRUMENT OF INTERNATIONAL ECONOMIC COOPERATION CAN BE STILL FURTHER IMPROVED AND EXPANDED.

DEBATE ON ECONOMIC SITUATION WILL BE FIRST ITEM ON AGENDA OF COMMISSION WHICH WILL THEN PROCEED TO EXAMINE REPORTS OF SUBORDINATE BODIES, COMMITTEES ON INDUSTRY AND TRADE INLAND TRANSPORT AND BUREAU OF FLOOD CONTROL AND WATER RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT.

OF PARTICULAR INTEREST WILL BE DISCUSSION ON REPORT PREPARED BY ECAFE'S WORKING PARTY ON ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND PLANNING THAT MET IN BANGKOK FOR FIRST TIME LATE 1955.

IN DEALING WITH VARIOUS REPORTS COMING UP AS AGENDA ITEMS COMMISSION WILL SURVEY OUTSTANDING PROBLEMS OF PRACTICALLY ALL BRANCHES OF ASIAN ECONOMIC LIFE. SPECIAL AGENDA TOPICS CONCERN SECRETARIAT'S ACTIVITIES IN FIELD OF STATISTICS AGRICULTURE AND

PROBLEMS OF BUDGETARY CLASSIFICATION. DELEGATES WILL ALSO CONSIDER PROGRESS ACHIEVED IN UN TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE ACTIVITIES IN REGION REPORT OF UN SEMINAR ON POPULATION IN ASIA AND FAR EAST QUESTIONS OF INTER REGIONAL TRADE CONSULTATIONS AND REPORTS OF VARIOUS SPECIALIZED AGENCIES.

AT PRECEEDING MEETING OF ECAFE'S COMMITTEE ON INDUSTRY AND TRADE TOTAL OF SEVEN REPORTS MOSTLY FROM TECHNICAL BODIES WILL BE DISCUSSED. THESE INCLUDE REPORTS ON IRON AND STEEL MINERAL RESOURCES ELECTRIC POWER COTTAGE AND SMALL SCALE INDUSTRIES TRADE HOUSING AND BUILDING MATERIALS AND TRAINED PERSONNEL FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.
