Dear Mr. Orrick,

Will you kindly refer to His Excellency Sithu U Aung Soe's D.O. letter No.295/10G56, dated the 27th January 1956, regarding the tentative programme for the Secretary-General of the United Nations, on his visit to Rangoon on the 6th February 1956?

I am to inform you that a slight change in the programme has been made for Tuesday the 7th February 1956. The Buffet Dinner by the Hon'ble Foreign Minister of Burma will be at the Strand Hotel at 19:45 hours and not at his residence. A new programme for the Secretary-General of United Nations is herewith enclosed for your information. I shall be grateful to you if you will kindly pass on a copy of the programme to the Secretary-General, on his arrival at Delhi.

In the absence of His Excellency the Burmese Ambassador who has left Delhi since the 29th January on an urgent official tour in South India, I am desired by my Government to call on His Excellency Mr. Dak Hammarskjöld, if it is not too inconvenient to the Secretary-General, to get some information relating to his visit to Rangoon. I should deem it a great favour if you could kindly arrange an interview with the Secretary-General any time convenient to him.
