In the course of the current contacts with the Governments party to the General Armistice Agreements, the Secretary-General has submitted to the Governments of Egypt and Israel certain proposals by the Chief of Staff, Major-General Burns, to strengthen the Observer Organization in the Gaza area, for the purpose of supporting compliance with the Armistice Agreement, especially the unconditional cease-fire and the orders issued for its enforcement of which the Secretary-General has been notified.

The proposals of General Burns have now been agreed to by both sides. They provide for the establishment, *on each side of* ~~along~~ the Demarcation Line, of a chain of fixed United Nations Observation Posts, to be supplemented by mobile United Nations patrols when necessary.
