PROGRAMME FOR CZECHOSLOVAKIA

Friday, 6 July Arrive Prague 11.05 am (CSA Flight 593)

Private lunch.

Visit to the French Gallery.

Dinner in the Secretary-General's honour at which members of the Government will be present and unofficial talks will take place.

Saturday, 7 July Morning -- The Secretary-General will be received by the President of the Republic.

Trip to Karlsbad, where the glassworks Moser and porcelain works EPIAG may be inspected.

Evening -- Private dinner in Prague

Sunday, 8 July Leave Prague by car approximately 8.00 am

NOTE RE CAR TRAVEL, PRAGUE TO VIENNA (Prague-Köln, Caslav-Jihlava-Moravske Budejovice-Znojmo-Haté (frontier) - Augenthal-Hollabrünn-Vienna)

The automobile route from Prague to Vienna has been agreed to between Dr. Matsch and Mr. Pscolka. The attached letter indicates the route for the Czech portion of the trip.

I have suggested to the Czechs that plans should be made to leave Prague by car at eight a.m. on Sunday, 8 July and to arrive at Haté at twelve-thirty. The actual contact between the two caravans will be Augenthal on the Austrian side of the border.

Dr. Matsch has suggested, and we have approved the idea of having luncheon at Horn (estate Hoyos) on the way to Vienna. I understand this represents a slight detour from the route, Augenthal to Vienna. With time out for lunch, this would probably bring you into Vienna around four-thirty in the afternoon.
