BERNADOTTE MEMORIAL PLAQUE REDEDICATED

UN 41112 - UNITED NATIONS, N.Y., 24 July 1953 -

The bronze plaque honoring the late Count Folke Bernadotte, United Nations Mediator in Palestine assassinated in Jerusalem on 17 September 1948, was rededicated today at a ceremony in the North Lobby of the General Assembly building at U.N. Headquarters. After an opening statement by U.N. Secretary-General Dag Hammarskjold, the memorial plaque was unveiled in its new location beside the Meditation Room by the President of the General Assembly, Mr. Lester B. Pearson (Canada), who then called for a minute of silence. The plaque had originally been unveiled and dedicated in a ceremony at Lake Success, the temporary home of the United Nations, a year after Count Bernadotte's death.
