General Vagn BENNIKE (of Denmark), Chief of Staff of the U.N. Truce Supervision Organization in Palestine, shakes hands with Mr. Dag HAMMARSKJÖLD, Secretary-General of the United Nations, before today's meeting of the Security Council. Gen. Bennike told the Council meeting that the recent flare-up of violence in the Holy Land may lead to a possible threat to the security of the area, and Mr. Hammarskjöld expressed his special concern about these outbreak of violence and appealed to the parties to avoid "premature actions which could jeopardise the Council's present endeavours."
