Your confidential letter 26 March. Pouching Desaynes letter 13 August 1958 which does not repeat not concern permanent premises. Schreiber memorandum 17 December 1958 was one of internal background papers prepared for attendance first session Commission and no further special significance need be attached to it. You may however wish use content memorandum in your negotiations with Government since it clearly sets forth Unations position on Government commitments regarding premises. Assume you have all other papers mentioned Schreiber's memorandum.

Will discuss with Desaynes contents your confidential letter 21 March after his return. Meanwhile can assure you there have been no negotiations with Government of which you not fully aware and believe you are in best position negotiate with Government on basis requirements now considered appropriate. Would appreciate your keeping us informed of developments with which we are very much concerned.

Mr. Loridan called on Secretary-General to say that his Government is not quite ready to ask for Mission stop. Have Mission while in Bruxelles express its surprise that no action has been taken on its recommendation. Stop Mission should ask for high calibre economic mission in position to deal with other relevant questions and should be dispatched before - repeat before - Ruanda-Urundi is discussed in Council.
