Mr. Secretary-General:

I have the honour to inform Your Excellency that the Council of the Organization of American States, in the meeting held on 28 June 1954, adopted the following resolution:

"THE COUNCIL OF THE ORGANIZATION OF AMERICAN STATES,

"Having considered the note presented by the Delegations Of Nicaragua, Peru, Cuba, Honduras, the United States, Panama, Haiti, the Dominican Republic, Brazil and Costa Rica, dated 26 June 1954, which requests the convocation of the Organ of Consultation in accordance with the Inter-American Treaty of Reciprocal Assistance,

"RESOLVES:

"1. To convoke a Meeting of Ministers of Foreign Affairs to serve as Organ of Consultation, in accordance with articles 6 and 11 of the Inter-American Treaty of Reciprocal Assistance, in order that it consider all the aspects of the danger to the peace and security of the continent as a result of the penetration of the political institutions of Guatemala by the international communist movement, and the measures that should be taken.

"2. To fix 7 July 1954 as the opening date of the meeting.

"3. To designate the city of Rio de Janeiro as the ~~sight~~<sup>Site</sup> of the meeting."
