From the to the

First day.

The partakers gather at 8,45 a. m. in Kungsträdgården at the statue of Charles XII.

Precisely at 9 o'clock drive: Kungsträdgården, Sturegatan to the park of Sport, worth seeing. Thence Karlavägen—Narvavägen—Friesen's park—Rosendal to Skansen where you stay an hour. Thence to the exhibition. Lunch there at 12 o'clock at the head-restaurant. The afternoon to be passed at the exhibition, where the following divisions ought to be seen: the tourists' and the sportexhibition, the fairy-grotto and the camera obscura. Dinner

Third day.

The partakers gather at 8,15 a. m. at the statue of Charles XII. Walk along Vesterlånggatan to Ränthemstaretrappan. Thence at 8,45 a. m. by steamer to Nackanäs. Lunch at 11 o'clock a. m. From Nackanäs by railway at 1,15 p. m. to Stadsgården. By the ferry to the exhibition. The bible gallery and ancient Stockholm ought to be seen. Dinner at 6 o'clock at the townhall-tavern in ancient Stockholm.

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Second day.

The partakers gather at 8,30 a. m. at the statue of Charles XII. At 9 o'clock a. m. by steamer from Riddarholmen to Drottningholm. The castle to be visited. At 11,30 a. m. lunch at the restaurant of Drottningholm. At 1 p. m. back to Stockholm. Visit in the church of Riddarholmen. At 6 o'clock p. m. dinner at Bern's saloon.

Third day.


The partakers gather at 8,15 a. m. at the statue of Charles XII. Walk along Vesterlånggatan to Räntmästaretrappan. Thence at 8,45 a. m. by steamer to Nackanäs. Lunch at 11 o'clock a. m. From Nackanäs by railway at 1,15 p. m. to Stadsgården. By the ferry to the exhibition. The biblic gallery and ancient Stockholm ought to be seen. Dinner at 6 o'clock at the townhall-tavern in ancient Stockholm.


Fourth day.

The partakers gather at 9 o'clock a. m. at the statue of Charles XII. Walk to the National museum which is to be visited. At 11 o'clock a. m. by steamer to the statue of Gustavus III and walk to St. Catherine's lift. Ascension to Mosebacke. Lunch there at 1,30 a. m. At 1 o'clock p. m. down by the lift to Stadsgården. Walk along Österlånggatan to the Royal Palace where the gala-apartments are to be seen, as well as the arsenal. At 4,15 p. m. from the statue of Gustavus III by the steamer »Gustafsberg» to Saltsjöbaden. Dinner at 6,30 p. m. at the restaurant of Saltsjöbaden. Back to Stockholm by rail. Train departs every hour from Saltsjöbaden.

Fifth day.

The partakers gather at 8,45 a. m. at the statue of Charles XII. Walk to the market-hall of Hötorget which is to be visited. Thence through the tunnel to Humlegården, where the statues of Linné and Scheele may be seen. From Humlegården by tram to Kungsträdgården. Lunch at 11,30 a. m. at Blanch's café. At 1,30 p. m. from the statue of Charles XII by steamer to Djurgården. Visit in the exhibition, in order to look at the following divisions: the naval plays, the exhibition of scenic art. Dinner at 6 o'clock at the headrestaurant of the exhibition.

 The program of every day will be finished with the dinner. With the dinner of the fifth day the tour is finished.
